Gospel Reflection: Luke 11:1-13

It does little good to sit back and wait for advantageous favor to find us. In this Gospel, Jesus encourages us to ask God for what we need and want. Our Father in heaven wants to hear our petitions, and he answers our prayers. Even fervent prayers may not always be answered to our preference, but our prayers are heard and lovingly received by our heavenly Father. God won't begrudge your timing or requests.

What role does prayer take in your life right now? When do you pray? What do you pray about? Now think about the role that prayer took in your life when you were a little kid. How often did you pray? What kinds of things did you pray about? When we pray, we honor God, which brings us closer to him. As we grow in prayer, we come to learn that praying isn't just about asking God for what we want. It is about submitting and giving your whole self over to God, knowing that God knows what you need better than you do. To call out to God as "Our Father" is to embrace the nearness and intimacy of God.

If we never gain anything from prayer except for the opportunity to grow closer to God, then that's enough for us. How do you allow your entire being to be a prayer of praise to God? If you don't have much of a prayer life right now, why do you think that is? Would you like to find more time and ways to pray?

FORMED: Pick of the Week Lectio – Evangelization Series

Session 4: Signs and Wonders

Some people might feel like miracles don't have as much of a place in the modern world because of lack of faith or openness to them—maybe we just aren't praying for miracles enough. Others might point to examples of answered prayer or miraculous healings as evidence that miracles can still be an opportunity to get people's attention and give evidence that God answers prayer.

This session begins by looking at the first of the signs and wonders recorded after Pentecost: Saints Peter and John's healing of the lame man at the gate of the temple. This miracle serves as an excellent example of the role signs and wonders play in evangelization, as well as the continuity between the miracles of the Old Testament and those of Christ and his Church. Please watch the next session in the Evangelization series to learn how important it is for us to pray for "greater boldness" as we ask for an outpouring of the Holy Spirit to help us proclaim the Word of God.
